

3rd Row—K. 1, increase once in next st., k. 22, increase once in next st., k. 2, increase once in next st., k. 22, increase once in next st., k. 1.

5th Row—K. 1, increase once in next st., k. 24, increase once in next st., k. 2, increase once in next st., k. 24, increase once in next st., k. 1.

7th Row—K. 1, increase once in next st., k. 26, increase once in next st., k. 2, increase once in next st., k. 26, increase once in next st., k. 2.

9th Row—K. 30, increase once in next st., k. 2, increase once in next st., k. 30.

11th Row—K. 31, increase once in next st., k. 2, inc. once in next st., k. 31.

13th Row—K. 32, inc. once in next st., k. 2, inc. once in next st., k. 32.

15th Row—K. 33, inc. once in next st., k. 2, inc. once in next st., k. 33.

Work 9 plain rows.

25th Row—K. 42, turn.

26th Row—Slip 1, k. 9, k. 2 tog., turn. Repeat 26th row twice.

29th Row—(K. 1, p. 1) five times, k. 2 tog., turn.

Repeat 29th Row until 51 sts. remain; work to end of row.

Proceed as follows:—

1st Row—Knit.

2nd Row—Purl.

3rd Row—* k. 1, wl. fwd., k. 2 tog.; repeat from * to end of row.

4th Row—Purl.

5th Row—Knit.

6th Row—Purl.

Now work 10 pattern rows once, then work 8 rows in plain smooth fabric.

Cast off.

To Make Up.

Press carefully. Sew up seam. Thread ribbon through holes at instep.

Knitted "Pippy" Shell Set

[Illustrated pages 22 and 23.]

Here is an exciting new stitch in this set and one that comes up just as well after tubbing, which is a very important item where a young baby is concerned.

Materials: 3 ozs 2-ply wool; 1 yd. crepe-de-Chine ribbon 1 inch wide, for bonnet, and 4 yds. narrow width; two bone knitting needles No. 10, two No. 11 and two No. 14; 1 small reel crochet silk; small quantity pink and green embroidery silk for roses.

Measurements: Length of coat from shoulder, 11½ inches; width at under-arm, 22 inches; length of sleeve, 5½ inches.

Abbreviations: K., knit; p., purl; tog., together; s., slip; m. 2, make 2 (by putting wool over needle twice); sts., stitches; w.f., wool forward.

Always knit into back of all cast on sts.

The Coat.

Cast on 280 sts. with No. 10 needles and knit two rows; then commence the "pippy" shell pattern as follows:—

Row 1—K. 8, * m. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 13, k. 2 tog., m. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

(Where the m. 2 occurs always work 2 sts., except in row 9.)

Row 2—K. 8, * p. 1, k. 17, p. 1, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 3—Knit.

Row 4—K. 8, * p. 2, k. 15, p. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 5—K. 8, * (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice k. 11, (k. 2 tog., m. 2) twice, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 6—K. 8, * p. 1, k. 1, p. 2, k. 15, p. 2, k. 1, p. 1, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 7—Knit.

Row 8—K. 8, * p. 5, (m. 2, k. 1) 14 times, p. 4, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 9—K. 8, * (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice, m. 2, (s. 1, drop the two made sts. of previous row) 14 times, s. 1. Return the 15 long sts. back on to the left-hand needle and knit them all tog., (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice, m. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 10—Purl, but in the m. 2 of previous row you p. 1, k. 1.

Row 11—Knit.

Row 12—Purl.

These 12 rows make the pattern. Repeat them five times more; then knit one row, reducing to 126 sts. and purl back to end of row and make the ribbon holes thus:—

Row 1—K. 1, * w.f., k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to last st., k. 1.

Row 2—Purl.

The yoke is made as follows:—

Row 1—Knit.

Row 2—K. 6, p. to last 6 sts., k. 6. Repeat these two rows once.

Right Side of Yoke.

K. 32, turn, cast off 2 sts.

Row 2—P. to last 6 sts., k. 6.

Row 3—Knit.

Work backward and forward on these 30 sts., as rows 2 and 3, until yoke is 3½ ins., ending with a purl row.

Cast off 12 sts. at beginning of next row and knit to end of row. Continue on these 18 sts. for six rows and cast off.

Back of Yoke.

Join wool at under-arm where the sts. were cast off.

Row 1—Cast off 2 sts., k. 60, turn.

Row 2—Cast off 2 sts., p. to end of row. Continue in stocking-st. on these 58 sts. until armhole is same as front. Cast off.

Left Front.

Join wool at under-arm and cast off 2 sts. Knit to end of row.

Row 2—K. 6, p. to end of row.

Row 3—Knit.

Repeat these two rows and shape neck and shoulder to correspond with right side. Cast off.

Sleeve.

Cast on 59 sts. and knit two rows.

Row 1—K. 2, * m. 2, k. 2 tog., k. 13, k. 2 tog., m. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2—K. 2, * p. 1, k. 17, p. 1, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 3—Knit.

Row 4—K. 2, * p. 2, k. 15, p. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 5—K. 2, * (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice, k. 11, (k. 2 tog., m. 2) twice, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 6—K. 2, * p. 1, k. 1, p. 2, k. 15, p. 2, k. 1, p. 1, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 7—Knit.

Row 8—K. 2, * p. 5 (m. 2, k. 1) 14 times, p. 4, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

Row 9—K. 2, * (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice, m. 2, (s. 1, drop the two made sts. of previous row) 14 times. Return the 15 long sts. back on to the left-hand needle and knit them all tog., (m. 2, k. 2 tog.) twice, m. 2, k. 2. Repeat from * to end of row.

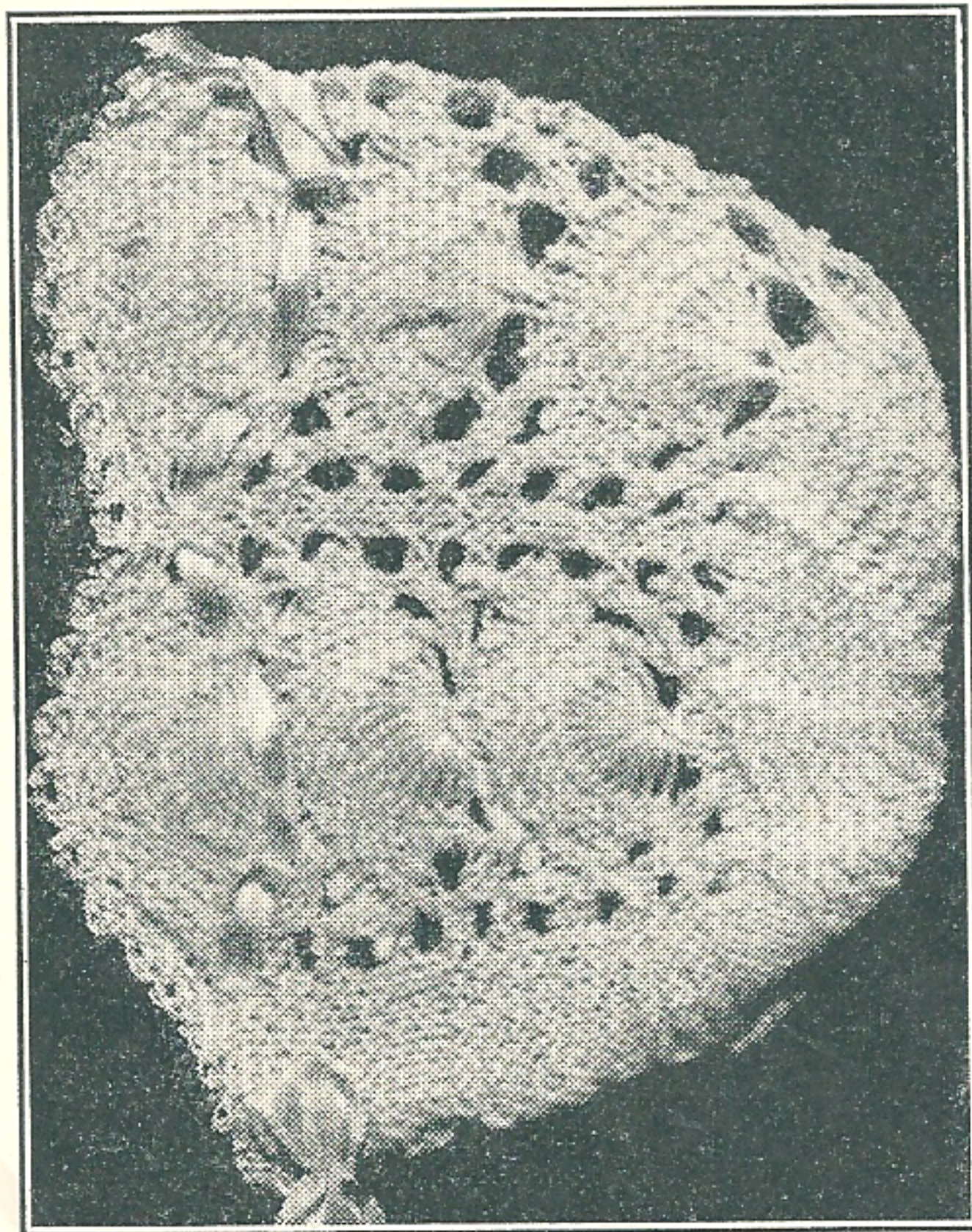
Row 10—Purl, but in the m. 2 of previous row you p. 1, k. 1.

Row 11—Knit.

Row 12—Purl.

Repeat these 12 rows three times and cast off loosely.

Make other sleeve exactly the same.



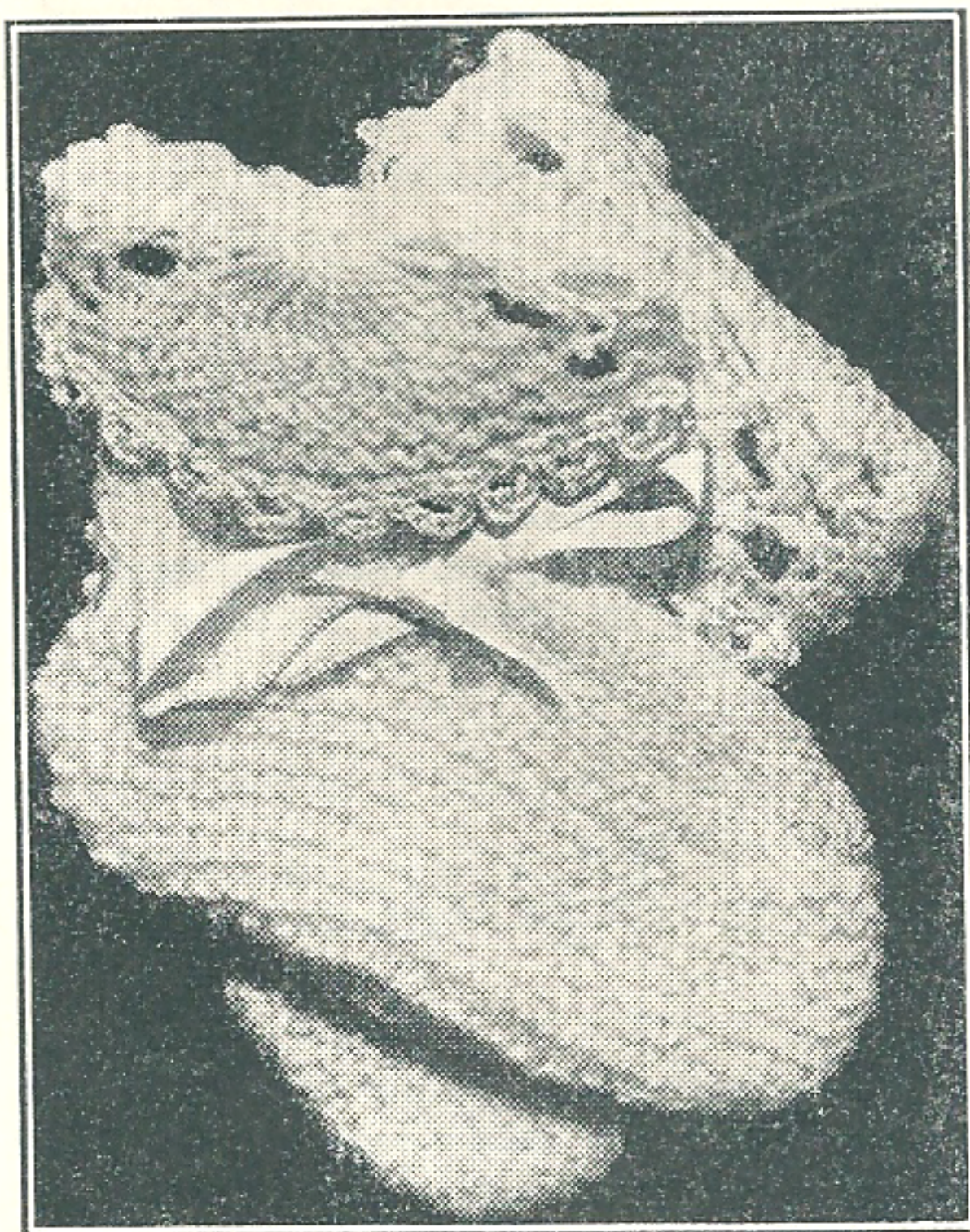
The Collar.

Cast on 116 sts. on No. 10 needles and knit two rows; then repeat the 12 pattern rows as given for sleeve once. Knit one

row, reducing to 100 sts.; then continue in stocking-stitch for 10 rows. Change to No. 14 needles.

Row 1—K. 1, * w.f., k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to last st., k. 1.

Work in a ribbing of k. 1, p. 1, for two rows and cast off ribwise.



To Make Up.

Press very lightly with a warm iron over brown paper. Sew up shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves, placing seam at under-arm. Attach collar to neck from edge to edge and sew in position. Thread ribbon through sleeves at top row of first shell. Embroider daintily with roses and thread ribbon at neck and waist.

The Bonnet.

Using No. 11 needles, cast on 90 sts and knit two rows. Repeat the 12 pattern rows as given for coat three times and make crown as follows:—

Row 1—* K. 8, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end. Knit 3 rows.

Row 5—* K. 7, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Row 6 and alternate rows—Knit.

Row 7—* K. 6, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Row 9—* K. 5, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

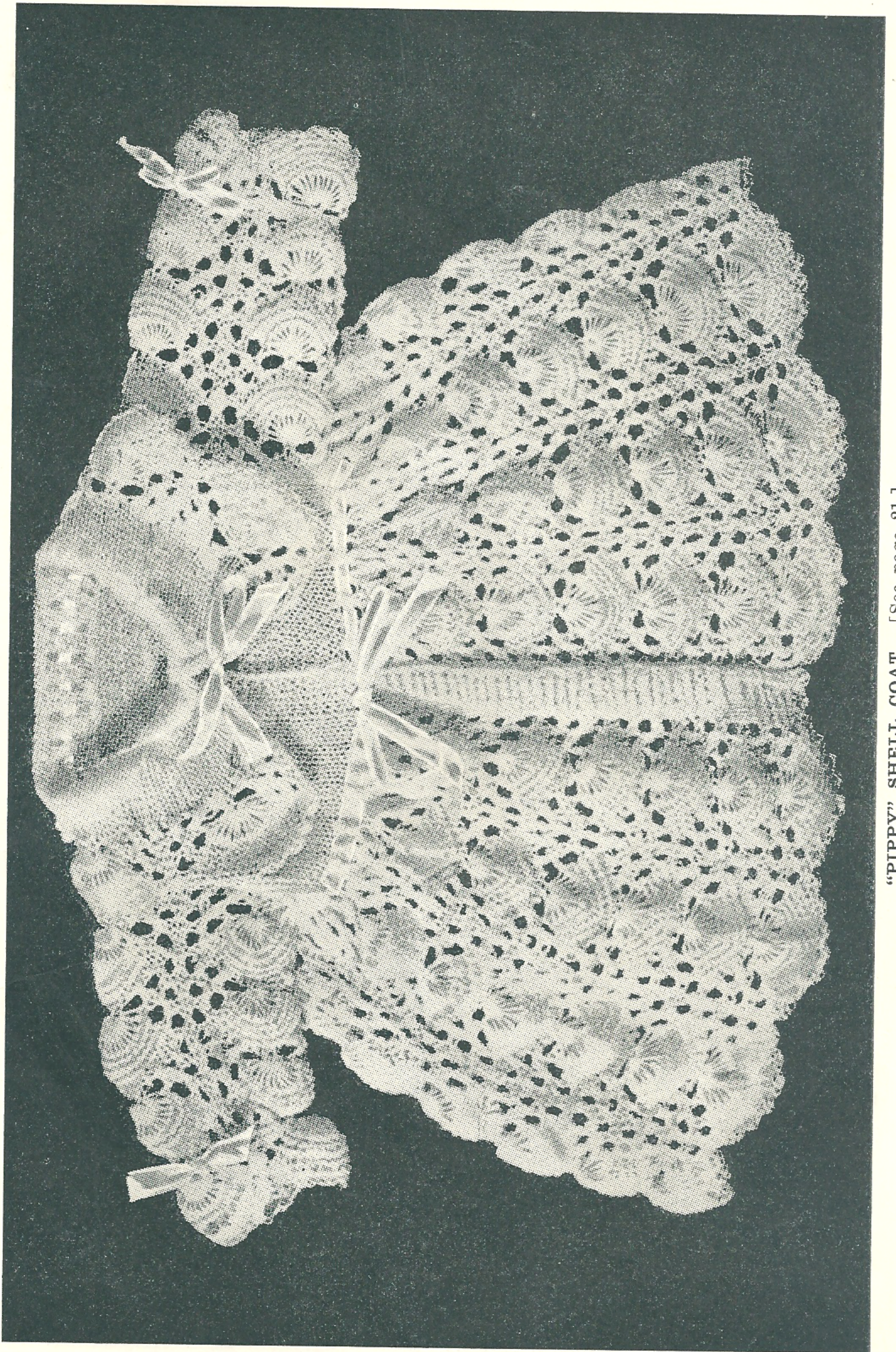
Row 11—* K. 4, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Row 13—* K. 3, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Row 15—* K. 2, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Row 17—* K. 1, k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to end.

Thread remaining sts. on wool, draw into a small circle and sew crown together to end of shell pattern. Press as given, thread ribbon across top of bonnet at end of first shell pattern and finish with a small bow on top. Attach side ribbons and embroider with roses.

Boots.

Using No. 11 needles, cast on 40 sts. and knit two rows; then repeat the 12 pattern rows as given for sleeve once.

Row 11—Purl.

Row 12—Knit.

Repeat these two rows eight times more, and make the ribbon holes as follows:—

Row 1—K. 1, * w.f., k. 2 tog. Repeat from * to last st., k. 1.

Row 2—Knit the st. and purl the loops to end of row.

Instep.

K. 26, * k. 12, turn, p. 12, turn. Repeat from * for 18 rows. Break off wool. With

right-hand needle, pick up and knit 9 sts. down side of instep and six across toe; take another needle and knit remaining 6 sts. across toe; pick up and knit 9 sts. along other side of instep and remaining 14 sts. from other needle. Knit 12 rows; then k. 2 tog. at both ends of both needles for six rows. Cast off. Sew up seams, embroider a rose on toe, thread ribbon at ankle and turn over the shell top.

Round the edges of entire set work as follows, with the crochet silk and a fine needle. Join silk into edge to be worked, * 3 ch., 1 tr. into same st. miss 2 sts., 1 double crochet into next st. Repeat from * all round.

His First Suit

All the interest is placed on "his very first suit," and this one is ever so easy to make.

Materials: 7 skeins of 3-ply wool, 3 small buttons, 1 yard narrow ribbon, two bone knitting needles No. 10 and two No. 12.

Measurements: Length of coat, 12 inches, width at underarm, 20 inches, sleeve, 6½ inches; jumper, length, 10 inches, width at underarm, 20 inches, sleeve, 3½ inches, pants and cap to correspond.

Abbreviations: Knit, k.; purl, p.; stitches, sts.; together, tog.; cable, b. (slip next 3 sts. on spare needle and let fall to back of work, k. 1, then p. 2, k. 1 from the spare needle); cable f. (slip next st. on spare needle and let fall to front of work, k. 1, p. 2, then k. the st. from the spare needle); stocking st., s.s.; w.r.n., wool round needle.

The Pants.

Using No. 10 needles cast on 72 sts. and work in a ribbing of k. 1, p. 1 for 5 rows.

Row 6—* k. 1, p. 1, w.r.n., p. 2 tog.; repeat from * to end of row.

Work 6 more rows in a ribbing of k. 1, p. 1. Continue now in s.s., increasing 1 st. at both ends of the needle in the 6th and every following 6th row until there are 90 sts. Work 6 rows, then cast off 3 sts. at beginning of every row until there are 30 sts. Work 2 rows, then cast on 3 sts. at beginning of every row until there are 90 sts. Work 6 rows, then decrease one st. at both ends of the next and every following 6th row until there are 72 sts. Continue on the 72 sts. for ½ inch, then shape as follows:—K. 42 turn, p. 12 turn, k. 22 turn, p. 32 turn, k. 42 turn, p. 52 turn, k. 62 turn, p. 72. Work 2 rows then make the ribbing to match front and cast off loosely.

Jumper.

Back: Cast on 72 sts. on No. 12 needles and work in a ribbing of k. 1, p. 1 for 22 rows. Change to No. 10 needles and

work in s.s. for 48 rows, then shape armholes by k. 2 tog. at both ends of the needle every row until there are 60 sts. Work 27 rows without shaping, then shape shoulders by casting off 18 sts. for shoulder; slip next 24 sts. on spare needle for back of neck, and cast off remaining 18 sts. for shoulder.

Front.

Cast on 72 sts. and work ribbing to match back then pattern as follows:—

Row 1—K. 16 * k. 1, p. 2, k. 1; repeat from * to last 16 sts., k. 16.

Row 2—P. 17 * k. 2, p. 2; repeat from * to last 19 sts., k. 2, p. 17; repeat rows 1 and 2 once.

Row 5—K. 16 * cable b.; repeat from * to last 16 sts., k. 16.

Row 6—Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more.

Row 11—K. 16 * cable f.; repeat from * to last 16 sts., k. 16.

Row 12—Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1 to 11 once.

Row 24—P. 21 * k. 2, p. 2. to last 23 sts. k. 2, p. 21.

Row 25—K. 20 * k. 1, p. 2, k. 1; repeat from * to last 20 sts., k. 20.

Row 26—P. 21 * k. 2, p. 2; repeat from * to last 23 sts., k. 2, p. 21. Repeat Rows 25 and 26 once.

Row 29—K. 20 * cable b. Repeat from * to last 16 sts., k. 16.

Row 30—Repeat Row 26.

Repeat Rows 25 and 26 twice more.

Row 35—K. 20 * cable f. Repeat from * to last 20 sts., k. 20.

Row 36—Repeat Row 26.

Repeat Rows 25 to 29 once.

Row 42—P. 25 * k. 2, p. 2. Repeat from * to last 27 sts., k. 2, p. 25.

Row 43—K. 24 * k. 1, p. 2, k. 1. Repeat from * to last 24 sts., k. 24.

Row 44—P. 25 * k. 2, p. 2. Repeat from * to last 27 sts., k. 2, p. 25.

Taking care to keep continuity of pattern on centre block of sts., k. 2 tog. at both ends of the needle every row until there are 60 sts.; then, when 4 blocks of
